



## Workforce Solutions of Providence/Cranston 2015 Youth Programs SUMMER 2015 PROGRAMS

The programs listed below are funded through the Job Development Fund from the Governor's Workforce Board-RI and through the RI Department of Human Services and will take place during July and August 2013. To participate in these programs, all applicants must go through one of the youth centers listed below. The process will include documentation, assessment and determination of eligibility by youth center staff.

**All participants must be legal residents of Providence or Cranston (or be a Ward of the State, such as a youth in foster care) and eligible to work.**

**Cranston Youth Center: 656 Park Ave. Cranston RI 562-8325**

**Bring Social Security Card, Birth Certificate, Proof of Address**

Each summer workforce development program will include job readiness training and a work experience placement. Successful participants will receive a Certificate of Work Readiness and a Certificate of Completion of Work Experience.

\*Some programs will also provide additional certifications.
